N°27 K. Sohlberg	Still lot of dust in the car, but satisfied of with his driving
N°25 Galli	He is not satisfied at all.
N° 5 P. Solberg	Dust in the cockpit. Brakes problems
N° 21 Sordo	He is glad he was able to do better than Galli and he is satisfied with the tyre choice
N°4 Hirvonen	he tried to push, but the roadbed is still too slippery for him. He didn't make mistakes even though is tough.
N° 1 Loeb	I drove like in the previous stage and I keep the concentration. I'm not pushing too much.

- N. 54 Burkart He had a puncture on the right front tyre 4 km after the start of the stage
- N. 48 Wilks I'm trying to hold on, I don't want to risk after all the problems I had so far
- N. 88 Alen I had a puncture in the stage 10. In stage 11 I was just behind Cortinovis and I was in his dust
- N. 71 Errani Problems with the central differential and bad traction.
- N. 102 Bettega I start to go better and I'm trying to catch up the others, but I cannot go faster.
- N. 107 Curtis I hit a rock few meters after the start and I hit the montante of the left door.pillar.
- N. 82 Eugeni With the start at 3 minutes he cannot catch up with the driver preceding him
- N. 108 Tali He has been slow down by the fire on Pileri's car
- N. 87 Tognozzi He catch up with Tali and procedded immediately behind losing time.
- N. 91 Lamonato He had a puncture at the fornt left tyre and bent an arm.
